Human Resource Name :

Munro, 'Captain' Charles; African, exact nationality unknown, presumed Kenyan from Birthplace

Known Cognomens :

Unknown, known to use multiple passports and identities throughout Southern and Central Africa

BlackEagle known aliases : 'Burke', native guide, 'Agari Mhbutu', Arms dealer.

Known Associates :

Muldoon, Robert (Deceased), game hunter, responsible for various illegal game hunts in african reserves between 1985 and 1993. BlackEagle file reference #INGEN032 (Inactive)

Hoare, Michael (Deceased), British Mercenary, South Africa, file reference #SA119 (Inactive)

Personal History :

Raised in Northern Frontier provinces of Kenya, born sometime between 1954, and 1956, illegitimate son of Scottish landowner and native housekeeper. Father murdered in Mau Mau uprisings, 1956, mother deceased in 1957 from natural causes. By 1974, operating as a white hunter, leading game parties into the bush, probably where he met Muldoon (cross reference #INGEN032) but by 1978, operating illegal gun smuggling operations into the independent upper Congo territories, expelled soon after due to 'political differences' with government officials. Joined mercenary group in the Congo area under command of Michael Hoare, (cross reference #SA119) and associated with atrocities in Avakabi during Operation Dragon Rouge around that time.

Re-emergence in Tangiers in 1981 in current role, as a sort of local celebrity in the area, the exact source of Munro's finances is still a mystery, but is believed to be associated with previous activities and contacts. While the 'Captain' title is still also believed to be a self bestowed rank, he has seen a great deal of combat, and is highly experienced in tropical areas. Currently believed to be still based in Tangiers he now acts as a 'Consultant' to foreign companies, providing supplies, arms, and guides to mining and resource based companies. Security operations have also been provided occasionally by Munro, but this is usually dependent on his current situation with both the authorities and local associates. Munro is persona-non-grata in several African provinces, but does not seem to encounter much difficulty passing throughout Africa using a multitude of passports and identities (although known by sight by most border officials, Africa is notorious for bribery and corruption). Munro's reputation for effectiveness is good, and is known for the best contact in the area for dangerous travel and resources, always with the discretion expected of such an operator.

Recent Information :

The most recent information BlackEagle holds is a collaboration between Munro, operating under the name 'Burke', where Munro provided his services as a guide to Cell 9 of BlackEagle Marseille in Algeria, and while Algeria is out of Munro's normal sphere of operations, his expenses were presumably being picked up by the Client, Carrien Technologies of PaloAlto.

The only incident of note before this is in 1989, when he was connected with the disastrous loss of a team of researchers from Earth Resources Technology Services, a now defunct company operating out of Houston, Munro, one of his employees, and two researchers were the only survivors of the eruption of Mukenko, a hitherto dormant volcano in the Congo valley, measuring a IX on the Morelli scale or eruption, and an 8 on the Richter scale, the rest of the party of 25 researchers, guides and porters accompanying Munro have never been accounted for, and the company financing the expedition filed for chapter 11 soon after.
